

Getting to CLARITY INFORMATICS

Newcastle has never been easier to get to with good rail, air, sea and road links. CLARITY INFORMATICS is right in the centre of the city with the Tyne Bridge to one side of the building.



On foot

At the end of Mosley Street turn right and look for the Business Services Authority building on your right and go through the underpass at their front door. At the end of the underpass turn right under the railway line, following signs for All Saint's Business Centre. Bede House is opposite and to your right as you emerge from the railway arches.

Please note when looking at maps of Newcastle our building is 50 metres above the river on a level with the Tyne Bridge so anything on the river side of the building is below us.



By Car

GPS W 1.60771° N 54.97041°

Whether traveling from the north or south, follow the A1 towards Newcastle. This takes you around the west side of the city. Whether you are traveling from the north or south, you should leave the A1 at the junction with the A167/A696 and follow the signs for the 'City Centre'. If you are traveling directly to CLARITY INFORMATICS or looking for the Dean Street car park, take the A167 exit marked "(A186) Walker, City Centre (South)".

When coming **from the North** the A167 travels under an underpass upon exiting the underpass there is an exit, ignore this, get in the inside lane and get ready to turn off at the next exit. It is an odd one as people are trying to get on the A167 at the exit! On coming up the ramp there are traffic lights which bring you on to Swan House Roundabout or 55° North, take the first exit going to Wallsend onto City Road (1 way system), head towards the quayside.

At the traffic lights turn right to pass the Travelodge entrance. Pass the Travelodge and take the first right for the Quayside car park. The car park entrance is on the right hand side near the 'Silk Room', to get to CLARITY INFORMATICS continue up the road until you get the last building and Bede House is on your left.

If you are traveling **from the west**, follow the A69 to the junction with the A1 and travel northbound. Leave the A1 at the next junction (City West, Westerhope, B6324) and follow the signs for City Centre A167 then as above.

There are many alternative routes when coming on the A1 **from the South** – the above is the easiest. However here is an alternative one that is quicker - follow "Gateshead & Newcastle (Centre) A186" after the Team Valley Industrial Estate (note: the A186 can also be accessed from the A1 before this check it is "Gateshead & Newcastle (Centre) A186"), keep in right lane and follow "Newcastle (Centre) A189" go over the Redheugh Bridge straight onto St James Boulevard then right onto Collingwood Street (3rd lights).

Follow this onto Mosley Street leading to Swan House Roundabout (note you can not turn right into Dean Street to the Car Park – you have to go round the large roundabout with 55° North. Take the first exit going to Wallsend onto City Road (1 way system), head towards the quayside. At the traffic lights turn right to pass the Travelodge entrance. Pass the Travelodge and take the first right for the Quayside car park and to get to CLARITY INFORMATICS. The car park entrance is on the right hand side near the 'Silk Room', to get to CLARITY INFORMATICS continue up the road until you get the last building and Bede House is on your left.

If you are using a GPS route finder then Bede House is on Pilgrim Street, Newcastle at NE1 2ES.

Parking is not normally possible in front of Bede House – although we do have a disabled bay. However there are numerous places to park very close by. The nearest being Dean Street car park which is just across the road, this is visible on the map above and the Quayside car park which is located near the Travelodge at the bottom of Manor Chare.

By Air

There are numerous airlines that fly direct to Newcastle from many UK and European cities.

Newcastle International Airport is only about seven miles North West of the city. A taxi from the Airport will take about 15 minutes, costing approximately £15.

You can also travel by Metro (rapid transit system) to the Central Station which will take about 25 minutes and cost around £2.50. CLARITY INFORMATICS is a 5 minute walk out of the station and to your right down Collingwood and Mosley Street or taxis are available outside the station.

By Ferry

The North Shields International Ferry Terminal is approximately seven miles east of Newcastle. Ferries run to Newcastle from a number of European countries, including Norway, Holland and Sweden.

- Amsterdam (Ijmuiden) (daily all year)
- Gothenburg and Kristiansand (twice per week)
- Bergen, Haugesund and Stavanger (two-three times per week)

You can also sail from Rotterdam (Holland) and Zeebrugge (Belgium) to Hull, which is approximately 150 miles south of Newcastle.

If you are a foot passenger, there are bus services from the terminal building to the city centre, which take approximately half an hour and cost £3. Taxis are available outside the ferry terminal, at a cost of around £12.

The nearest Metro station is Percy Main, about 20 minutes' walk from the terminal building. The Metro journey into the city centre takes 15-20 minutes and costs around £2.50.
